Vinification	Small concrete and stainless steel vats for parcel selection Cold pre-fermentation maceration for one week at 5°C then fermentation alcoholic fermentation with indigenous yeasts, temperature 25°C for 10-15 days Post-fermentation vatting 1 to 2 weeks depending on the vintage
Maturation	20hl Stockinger oval cask No fining or filtration
Bottling	At the property, total SO2 L 30 mg/l Nitrogen inerting of the bottles before filling Conical bottle
Presentation	Wooden case 6 bottles
